Facilities, Fees & Charges 2022 to 2023

Housed in a former church, the All Saints Centre was given to the town of Lewes in 1980 as an arts, community and youth venue.

The Main Hall

Features include entrance foyer with bar, toilets, kitchenette, wooden floor, additional balcony seating, a stage and a pipe organ. Floor space 11.5m x 10.7m which include balcony pillars. Ground floor is fully accessible. Maximum capacity for a closely seated audience is 152 when on the ground floor using our tiered seating and additional folding chairs. There are an additional 48 fixed seats on the first floor (balcony) seating rake. The capacity is 126 when used for functions utilising seating at tables (ground floor only).

The Small Hall

Features include access from a separate entrance, wooden floor, wall of mirrors and original stained-glass windows. Floor space 6.5m x 6.2m. Fully accessible from main entrance, 3 steps must be negotiated from side entrance.
