Installation of 1no window to 1st floor of flank elevation

b) SDNP/24/03462/HOUS & SDNP/24/03893/LIS - 18 Castle Ditch Lane, Lewes

Installation of 1no roof light to northern roof slope and installation of twin wall flue to wood burner of a Grade II Listed Building

c) SDNP/24/03739/LIS - 5 North Street, Lewes

Change of use from part class E and part class C3, to class C3 only, including layout and external alterations, to provide a single dwellinghouse

d) SDNP/24/03531/CND - 1 Hamsey Crescent,

Variation of Condition 2 (plans) related to Planning Approval SDNP/24/01895/HOUS to include new materials such as the corteen steel dormer being hung with plain tiles and removal of rendering on first floor level

e) SDNP/24/03796/HOUS - 27 St Annes Crescent, Lewes

Erection of shed in front garden

f) SDNP/24/03878/FUL - Barber Court, St Pancras Road, Lewes

Replace all existing white framed double-glazed UPVC windows with UPVC double glazed windows and all curtain wall glazing to the communal areas to be replaced

#### **Trees**

To consider the response of Lewes Town Council to the following tree planning applications:

- a) SDNP/24/03745/TCA Castle Precincts Cottage, Castle Precincts, Lewes
- T1 Italian Black Plum reduce and reshape crown by up to 2 metres
- T2 Copper Beech in Castle Precincts prune back overhang to house by up to 3 metres to growth points to give clearance to property

#### b) SDNP/24/03965/TCA - 111 Michael Bell Ltd , High Street, Lewes

T3 - Tulip - Reduce top section of crown by approximately 4m, remainder of lower crown to be reduced by 1m, leaving a good shape to the tree, remove deadwood and thin crown by 15%

#### c) SDNP/24/03987/TCA - The Croft, Church Lane, Lewes

T4 - Group of Elder Trees - remove major deadwood T6 & T20 - Bay - trim shape by no more than 0.5 metres T8 & T9 - Variegated Holly - remove major deadwood T12, T13, T14, T15, T16 & T17 - Robinia - remove major deadwood

#### d) SDNP/24/03983/TCA - 19 Winterbourne Mews, Lewes

T1 - Copper Beech - reduce lower crown by approximately 2.5-3.0 metres to growth points, thin crown by up to 10%, remove deadwood and crossing branches

#### e) SDNP/24/04024/TCA - 13 The Avenue, Lewes

Bay (T1) - Crown reduce multi stem bay to 3 meters. Remove 2 stems
Pear (T2) - Crown reduce multi stem pear by 3 meters on all aspects. Remove 3 stems
Purple plum (T3) - Cut back and crown lift
Purple plum (T4) - Cut back and crown lift. Crown reduce by 2 meters. Crown thin

#### f) SDNP/24/04139/TCA - Friends Meeting House, 32 Friars Walk, Lewes

T1 - Lime - Crown raise to 3.5m and reduction of lateral branches by 2 meters while maintaining the upper canopy

#### g) SDNP/24/04037/TPO - Baxters Field, Paddock Lane, Lewes

T003 - European Lime - Fell tree to ground level or pollard at 2.5m from ground level T004 - European Lime - Re-pollard at historical pollard points and remove dead wood

## h) SDNP/24/04063/TCA - 24 South Street, Lewes

T1 and T2 - Maple - fell trees to ground level

T3 - Birch - reduce and reshape crown by 1-2m from top and sides back to growth points

T4 - Birch - reduce and reshape crown by 2-3m from top and sides back to growth points

## i) SDNP/24/04067/TCA - 17 Prince Edwards Road, Lewes

T1 - Plum - fell and remove - tree is causing damage to garden wall, which is bowing towards neighbouring property
